ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR PARTICIPATION

- Age on 28th February 2026, should be below 32 years for male and 35 years for female candidates.
- Research experience of two years after obtaining a post-graduate degree in the science subjects listed above or bachelor's degree in the case of medical/engineering/technology subjects.
- Original research papers with single authorship will be acceptable. The work should have been carried out in the State of Chhattisgarh and not presented/published elsewhere is an essential requirement.
- Awardees of previously held Chhattisgarh Young Scientist Congress shall not be eligible for participation, for a period of three years, from the date of last award.
- Kindly note that Plagiarism will be checked and summarily rejected, if found to contain plagiarised material.
